While living in New York, Rebecca worked at The Lamb's Theatre (the former Lamb's Club), where she became House Manager. She has appeared in local commercials and in the television series, *Super Force*, filmed at Universal Studios in Orlando.

Rebecca makes Lakeland her home base, while she continues her professional career, and teaches voice, dance and drama to aspiring young artists. She is a member of AEA, SAG and ASCAP. Rebecca is also a Christian song-writer and dramatist. A few of her Lakeland credits include: Musical Director and Vocal Coach for Theatre Winter Haven's performance of *Funny Girl*, Soloist and choreographer for St. David's Episcopal Church's production of *Godspell*, Featured Artist, Assistant Director and Musical Staging Director for The Encore Theatre's presentation of *Crazy for Gershwin*, Amanda in the Pied Piper's production of Noel Coward's *Private Lives*, Diction/Character coach for Harrison Arts Center's *My Fair Lady*, choreographed Harrison Arts Center's *Pirates of Penzance*. Rebecca, formerly a music instructor at All Saints Academy, is currently, a vocal coach for the musical theatre program at Harrison Arts Center, adjunct for voice at Polk Community College, and instructor at Prodigy Program for At-Risk-Children.
